MOTHER TONGUE LANGUAGES (MTL) LANGUAGE CAMP AND MTL FORTNIGHT

The objectives of organizing the MTL Language Camp and MTL Fortnight are to provide an environment for students to immerse in their respective Mother Tongue Languages and to appreciate the cultures through hands-on tasks such as drama, performances and story-telling.

The Mother Tongue Language & Cultural Day camp will be organised for Primary 3 on Wed, 24 May from 7.40am to 3.30pm. The MTL Fortnight will be held during Term 3 Week 2 & 3 (from Tue 4 Jul to Fri 14 Jul). During the two events, students will be able to enjoy a wide range of activities such as Storybook Design, Singing Competition, Story-telling, Cultural and Language Quiz, Speech & Drama Workshop, Comics Workshop and Performing Arts Workshop.
